WHO IS MDW Ltd?

Murray Darling Wetlands Ltd. was established in 2009 as an initiative of the NSW Murray Wetlands Working Group Inc. (MWWG), an award winning community based wetland rehabilitation group.

The company is a not-for-profit organisation registered under the Australian Securities Commission as a charity. It has a Board of Directors and members from the wider community, including scientists, landholders, conservationists, government, the Murray Darling Association and Murray-Darling Freshwater Research Centre.

As a non-profit company Murray Darling Wetlands Ltd. seeks corporate and public donations as well as donations of water for wetland and environmental uses.

The company has 'deductible gift recipient status' with the Federal Government and is listed on the Register of Environmental Organisations
